2 box of tissues

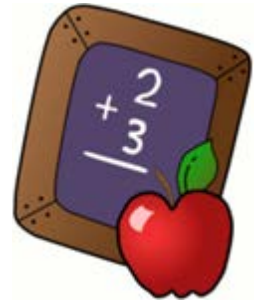
Blunt Scissors (fiskar brand can be found at Wal-Mart)

- ✓ #2 pencils - sharpen at home (mechanical pencils are OK if students use them properly)
- ✓ 4 Two pocket folders with brads (plastic or vinyl) red, green, purple, & blue
- ✓ Colored Pencils - (Crayola Twistables Colored Pencils save a lot of time used in sharpening, but are not required. NO markers please!)
- ✓ Crayons- (Box of 24)
- ✓ 3 composition books with pages sewn in - no spiral
- ✓ 2 packs 3x5 index cards (ruled or unruled)
- ✓ Hand held pencil sharpener (to be kept at home)
- ✓ Highlighters - yellow only please
- ✓ 2 black EXPO dry erase markers (to be kept at school)
- ✓ 3 packs of loose leaf paper - wide-ruled (to be kept at school)

- ✓ * **TWO Mead FIVE STAR Spiral Notebooks – 5 Subject - 11 x 8½ inch in size**
The 11 x 8½ inch notebooks are usually college ruled, which is OK. Size is VERY IMPORTANT! **DO NOT** get 10½ x 8 inch! Student note pages will NOT FIT in the smaller notebooks. One will be used for Language Arts with Mrs. Doss and one for science & social studies with Ms. Edwards.

- ✓ * **ONE Mead FIVE STAR Spiral Notebooks – 3 Subject - 11 x 8½ inch in size**
The 11 x 8½ inch notebooks are usually college ruled, which is OK. Size is VERY IMPORTANT! **DO NOT** get 10½ x 8 inch! Student note pages will NOT FIT in the smaller notebooks. This will be used for Miss Zimmerman's math class.

- ✓ #2 pencils – sharpen at home (NO mechanical pencils)
- ✓ 2 - Two pocket plastic folders (one purple folder and one green folder)
- ✓ Crayola Twistables Colored Pencils
- ✓ Hand held pencil sharpener (to be kept at home)
- ✓ 3 packs of loose leaf paper – wide-ruled (to be kept at school)
- ✓ GLUE STICKS – Many will be used! Stock up early while they are on sale. No liquid glue!
- ✓ Scissors (blunt tip)
- ✓ Zippered pencil pouch
- ✓ 12 inch ruler with in/cm
- ✓ 2 blue EXPO dry erase markers (to be kept at school)
- ✓ 3 boxes of tissues

- ✓ Homework Agendas/Planners are required and will be available for purchase at school – these usually cost about \$3.00

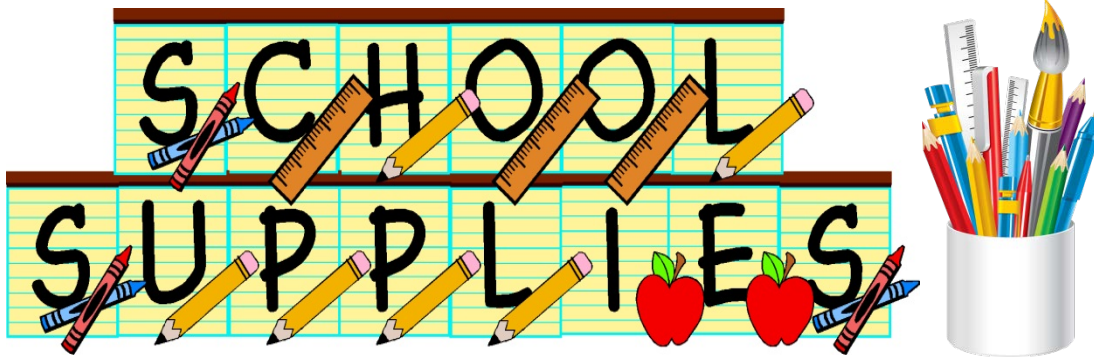

- ✓ **Two** - 3 ring zip around binders (These binders come in a variety of styles and prices (some are much more inexpensive than others). They need to be durable, since they will be your child's main textbooks throughout the year.)



- ✓ 1 **vinyl/plastic** pocket folder (no brads)
- ✓ 4 tab dividers
- ✓ Post-it **TABS** by 3M - usually 36 tabs in a pack (These are "durable, writable, and repositionable" in the colors red, yellow, blue.)



- ✓ sheet protectors
- ✓ hole reinforcers - any color
- ✓ 1 pack of copy paper
- ✓ 3 packs wide-ruled loose leaf notebook paper



- ✓ pencils/erasers (mechanical pencils are OK **if used correctly**)
- ✓ 2 zippered pencil pouches (1 for pencils/1 for flashcards)
- ✓ colored pencils
- ✓ hand held sharpener to sharpen pencils at home
- ✓ highlighters (any color)
- ✓ Expo dry-erase markers
- ✓ Fine point Sharpie (permanent)
- ✓ glue sticks
- ✓ scissors
- ✓ 4 boxes of tissues
- ✓ headphones or ear buds
- ✓ planner (purchase at Union Hall Open House)
