- 2 cans of Play-Doh
- 3 large glue sticks
- 2 zippered cloth pencil bags with clear front made for a three ring binder
- 1 red three ring binder (1 inch)-with inside pockets and clear front
- 1 blue three ring binder (2 inch)-with inside pockets and clear front
- 3- 8 count packs of Crayola jumbo size crayons (these are larger than other jumbo crayons and won't break)
- 1 - Refill bottle of Hand Sanitizer
- 1 - Refill bottle of Antibacterial Soap
- 6 - Ticonderoga Beginner pencils with erasers (large size pencils)
- 3 - large erasers (no cap erasers/white nylon does best)
- 1 - box of sandwich size zip lock bags (boys only need to bring these)
- 1 - box of gallon size zip lock bags (girls only need to bring these)
- 3 - canisters Lysol Wipes
- 3 - tubs Baby Wipes (1 pack weekly - approximately - for students in diapers)
- 2 - bags Diapers or Pull-ups (for students who wear them - send as needed - we will let you know when 1 bag is finished so you can send another... that way we don't run out)
  - 1 - Child-sized headphones (ONLY your child will wear these - the more comfortable, the better. Most children do best with the "over the whole ear" type. These will be used at both the computer and at the Listening Center.)

**First Grade Supply List**

*(For the safety of our students the accepted brands are Germ-X, Equate, Parent's Choice, and Purell.)*
- 1 box of Ziploc bags** (gallon or quart please) \*
- Please buy a set of **addition and subtraction flash cards** to KEEP AT HOME for practicing math facts throughout the year.
- a book bag** (Please no rolling book bags for safety and storage reasons.)

Please put your child's name on their supplies **except for the ones that will be shared**. The asterisk (\*) to the right of an item indicates it will be shared. Leave all crayons in their original boxes when sending them to school with your child. Throughout the year, you will need to send more supplies to school as needed.

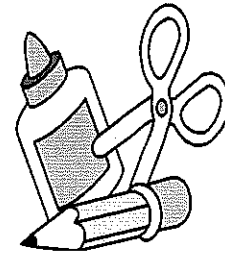

*\*Please bring the following items to Open House on Monday, August 7, 2017. Additional supplies will be needed later in the year. A second list will be sent home at a later date.*

- One inch binder (*do not buy anything any larger please*)
- 2 boxes of #2 pencils
- 1 red vinyl 3 prong folder with pockets
- 1 pack of erasers (*cap erasers only*)
- 6 dry erase markers (*black only*)
- 1 boxes of crayons (*24 ct. only*)
- 6 glue sticks
- Scissors
- Headphones (*no ear buds please*)
- 2 marble notebooks (*wireless*)
- 2 packs of notebook paper
- 2 packs of index cards
- *Large zipper pencil pouch (no boxes please)*
