4th Grade Supply List

- 3 24 count boxes of #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- 2 boxes of 24 crayons
- 1 box of colored pencils

- 3 one subject notebooks – Labeled for Science, VA Studies, and Music
- 2 five subject notebooks – Labeled for Language Arts and Math
- 4 PLASTIC pocket folders with PRONGS
- 8 pocket folders with PRONGS
- 2 small pairs of scissors
- 2 packs of cap erasers (no novelty erasers)
- 1 pair of headphones (We have the children’s headphones who had them in third grade.)
- 20 glue sticks
- Assignment notebook (get at school during Open House)
- 1 box of quart size (girls) or 1 box of gallon size Ziplock bags (boys)
- 1 pack of 3 x 3 Post-It notes
- 1 pack of index cards
- 2 highlighters
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 ultra-fine point and 2 fine tip Sharpie permanent markers – BLACK ONLY
- 1 four pack of multicolored EXPO Dry Erase Markers
- 1 Soft-sided Spacemaker pencil box (Must have the soft kind that zips. It will not break when dropped making it easier to transport from room to room.)
- Girls – 1 bottle of Germ-X or Purell hand sanitizer (see below)
- Boys – 1 bottle of liquid soap must be Dial or Softsoap (see below)
- 2 cans of Clorox wipes (see below)
