## Pittsylvania County Schools

### CLASS SIZES – TEACHER/PUPIL RATIOS 2019-2020

As required by §22.1-253.13:1G of the Code of Virginia, school divisions shall report to the public the actual teacher/pupil ratios in elementary schools for the current school year. This section of the Code of Virginia states that “such actual ratios shall include only the teachers who teach the grade and class on a full-time basis and shall exclude resource people.” Another requirement of §22.1-253.13:1G is that school boards report teacher/pupil ratios which include resource teachers.

Included in the chart below is the average class sizes and average teacher/pupil ratios for grades K-3 and grades 4-5 for each elementary school in the Pittsylvania County School System.
